Ephesians 1:15-23; 1 Timothy 2:1-7

Get Started

1. Have you ever need someone to mediate a dispute between you and someone else? What was that experience like? What role did the mediator play?

About the Passage(s)

1. Paul notices two things about the people of Ephesus that lead him to remember/pray for them. What are they (Ephesians 1 v.15)?

2. Paul prays that you would have “the eyes of your heart enlightened, that you may know” three things. What are those three things? What do they mean? (Ephesians)

3. What are some of the things that uniquely qualify Jesus to be the one mediator? (Also see Hebrews 1)

Sermon Talking Points

1. What did Luther observe in the practice of the church that caused him to advocate for ‘Solus Christus’, that salvation is through Christ alone?

2. Is there a difference between the fear of the Lord and being afraid of God?

3. Why do we need a mediator between us and God?

Apply This

1. A well-known Christian motto goes like this, “To know Christ and make Him known.” Paul prays the first half of that statement for the people in Ephesus. How can our HomeGroup do/encourage both parts (a: to know Him b: to make Him known)?
