Get Started

1. Have you ever travelled to a place where you did not speak the language? What happened? How did you feel?

Dig Deeper

1. Why were the disciples supposed to wait in Jerusalem? (see Luke 24:48,49 and Acts 1:8)
2. Why did God wait until Pentecost, a Jewish harvest festival (Deut. 16:9-10) to give the Holy Spirit?
3. What would you say is the most impressive evidence of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost? Why?
4. Do you think the disciples were in a private house or a public place when the Spirit came? Why might the location be significant? (see Luke 24:50-53; also reflect on Acts 7:44-50)
5. The disciples received the Spirit on Pentecost. What enduring lessons do we learn from their actions about how we might know the power of the Spirit?

Apply This

1. If we believe in Jesus then we are assured that the Spirit of God dwells in us. However, there are times when we sense God's presence and power in special ways. When have you experienced a special empowering from God to witness about Jesus?
2. As a congregation, our desire is to increase our witness locally and globally. Does the thought of building momentum in mission make you nervous or excited? Are there some opportunities for witness that you feel God calling you to explore as a Life Group?
